On Sunday, August 25, 2024, in Port St. Lucie, Florida, Cheryl Duncombe passed away from heart disease at the age of 77. She is survived by her loving husband of eighteen years, Richard Duncombe. Cheryl is also survived by her four adult children, Brian Donovan of Pittsburgh, Erin Vok of West Palm Beach, Chad Penrod of Pittsburgh, and Amy Crytzer of Akron. She was also "Nana" to ten

grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Born and raised in Moon Twp., near Pittsburgh Pennsylvania, Cheryl was the daughter of the late David Donovan and Olga Preslak. She was also pre-diseased by her brother, Dennis Donovan. Cheryl graduated from Moon Twp High School in 1965, and went on to obtain a Bachelors degree in Education from Slippery Rock University in 1969.

After working a number of years as a teacher and a social worker, Cheryl capped off her career as a Welfare Fraud Investigator with the PA OIG. While working with the OIG, she distinguished herself with numerous awards and citations.

During her retirement years Cheryl became an accomplished painter and the author of two books.

Cheryl's remains were cremated, according to her wishes, and will be placed in the holy ground of St. Margaret's Garden in Mt. Lebanon, PA. Her life will be celebrated with a dedication Mass at St. Paul's Episcopal Church at a time to be announced later.
