compliance with the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Section 17 designates the Note as a qualified tax-exempt obligation. Section 18 ratifies the advertising of this notice and authorizes publication of a notice of final enactment. Section 19 appoints professionals. Section 20 authorizes the officers of the Township to take all necessary action in connection with the issuance of the Note. Section 21 authorizes the payment of all expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Note. Section 22 specifies allowable investments. Section 23 sets forth the authorization of officers. Section 24 establishes a Clearing Account. Section 25 establishes a Rebate Fund. Section 26 sets forth severability provisions. Section 27 repeals all inconsistent ordinances or portions thereof. Section 28 sets forth the effective date of the Ordinance. The full text of the foregoing proposed Ordinance may be examined by any citizen between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. prevailing time, on regular business days at the office of the Township, 325 Fox Chapel Road, Pittsburgh, Penda, Pittsburgh, Penda, Persuant to Act 20 of 1993, a reasonable period for public comment will be made available during the Council meeting.
