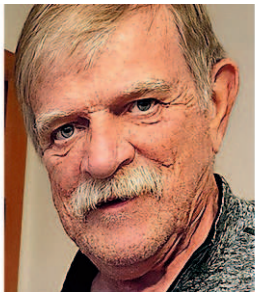


ROBERT STEPHEN CSUKAS
