Daniel Richard Flukas, 78, of Phoenix, AZ, passed away on Wednesday, September 11, 2024. He was born in Pittsburgh, PA, on September 25, 1945. Daniel received a Bachelor of Science degree in Education, in the summer of 1967 from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. He also received a Master of Public Administration from Arizona State University, in the fall of 1985. On May 1, 1971, he married Karen Joyce Hayden

in Greensburg, PA.

Daniel served two years in the Army, primarily as a Motor Platoon Officer, and later as an Executive Officer, assigned to Company C of the 23rd Infantry Regiment (M*), 2nd Infantry Division, while stationed in Korea. After leaving Korea, he served as Company Supply Officer, at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina. Daniel worked as a Personal Generalist at Slippery Rock State College, in Pennsylvania.
