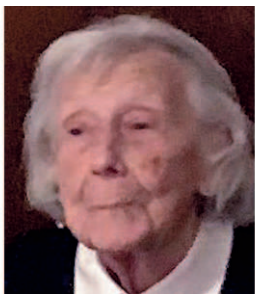


ANNE (RODGERS) HUTCHINSON
