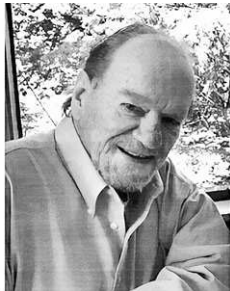


DENNIS L. CRIBBINS
