Michael attended Indiana University of Pennsylvania majoring in Criminology.

After graduating, Michael started his career as a deputy U.S. Marshal in the District of Columbia Superior Court in 1990. Michael transferred to the Pittsburgh office in 1995 to be closer to family. During this time, he spearheaded the Western Pennsylvania Fugitive Task Force. He was promoted to Chief Deputy U.S. Marshal in 2011 and then was presidentially appointed as United States Marshal for the Western District of Pennsylvania in 2019. In 2021, Michael's Alma Mater, IUP, presented him with the Distinguished Alumni Award, the highest honor given by IUP annually.

Michael is survived by his devoted wife Charmaine; his children Tyler (Allison) Baughman and Jenna (Jason) Mezyk; his grandchildren, Madeline, Colin, Ethan, Jack, and soon-to-be granddaughter; his siblings, nieces, nephews, and many dear friends and extended family.
