Russell Hunter Hall, 64, of Abingdon, MD, passed away on October 7, 2024. Born on August 18, 1960, in Wilkinsburg, PA, he was the younger of two sons of Joyce E. Hall and the late Ralph E. Hall of Level Green, PA. Russell graduated from Penn-Trafford High School in Harrison City, PA, in 1978, and went on to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Human Resources and Labor Relations from Indiana
