BOROUGH OF HEIDELBERG ORDINANCE NO. 650 ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HEIDELBERG, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2025. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, BY THE HEIDELBERG BOROUGH COUNCIL THAT A TAX BE LEVIED ON ALL REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HEIDELBERG SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 AS FOLLOWS: Section 1 – Tax Levy: That a tax is hereby levied on all real property within the Borough of Heidelberg subject to

tax is hereby levied on all real property within the Borough of Heidelberg subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2025 as follows: A tax rate for general revenue, debt, public safety, road improvement and solid waste removal purposes to be set at 9.45 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. **Section 2 – Discounts:** Pursuant to Section 10 of the Local Tax Collection Law, a taxpayer subject to the payment of a tax levied by this taxpayer subject to the payment of a tax levied by this Ordinance shall be entitled to a discount of two percent (2%) from the amount of such tax upon making payment of the whole amount of such tax within two months after the data of the tax patient

whole amount of such tax within two months after the date of the tax notice. Section 3 – Penalties: A taxpayer subject to the payment of a tax levied by this Ordinance, who shall fail to make a payment of such tax for four months after the date of the tax notice, shall be charged a penalty of ten percent (10%), and the penalty shall be added to the tax by the tax collector and shall be collected by the tax collector. Section 4 – Effective Date: This Ordinance and the real estate tax shall take effect as of January 1, 2025. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED that any Ordinance, or part of an Ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
