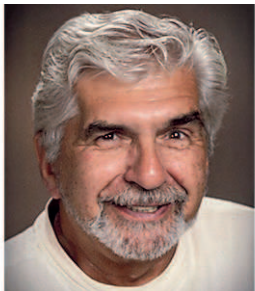


## EDWIN F. PEGDAN
