

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the PENNSYLVANIA CLEAN STREAMS LAW, the PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION Rules and Regulations, the SURFACE MINING CONSERVATION and RECLAMATION ACT, and the BITUMINOUS MINE SUBSIDENCE and LAND CONSERVATION ACT as amended, notice hereby is given that Consol Mining Company LLC, doing business at 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has made application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for renewing its existing Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 02141301 and the related NPDES Permit No. PA0215571 for the Harmar Mine, 14-North AMD Plant and Strohm Borehole. The current permit 02141301 was issued on 06/06/2024 and will expire on 05/25/2025. This renewal does not contain revisions to the existing operation. The permit consists of 12.6 surface acres and is located in Harmar and Indiana Townships and Fox Chapel Borough, Allegheny County. The 14-North AMD Plant is located approximately 4,700 feet northwest from the intersection of Campbell Run Road and Guys Run Road. The Strohm Pump is located approximately 3,000 feet from the intersection of Route 910 and Saxonburg Boulevard. The New Kensington West, PA, U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map contains the area described. The receiving stream for Outlet 001 is Campbell Run and receiving stream for Outlet 002 is Deer Creek.
