**PINE STREET PEDESTRIAN
BRIDGE REPAIRS**

General Construction

This project involves the demolition of the existing concrete deck on the Pine Street Extension Pedestrian Bridge, installation of a new timber deck and new railings. Concrete abutment repair is also included. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside with the words **PINE STREET PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REPAIRS**. All proposals must be in the hands of Mary Ellen Ramage, Borough Manager, 437 Butler Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15223, before **11:00 am prevailing time on Wednesday, December 11, 2024** and the same will be publicly opened and read at that time at the Borough Building located at 437 Butler Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15223. Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set, beginning on Tuesday, November 26, 2024. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. An additional \$10.00 will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed. **Prevailing wage rates will be required to be paid on this contract.** Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Borough of Etna, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. **The anticipated Commencement of Work is Winter / Spring 2025.** The Proposals must be made to Borough of Etna Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee. Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement. The Borough of Etna reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein. The Borough reserves the right to award a contract for all or any portions of the project and accompanying work listed in the proposal. The Municipality also reserves the right to add or delete portions of the work after award of the contract. The contract price for any additional work provided by the Contractor shall be determined for the unit prices within these contract documents.
