
RONALD C. CARLISLE

Ronald C. Carlisle, of Upper St. Clair, previously of Carnegie, died on October 14, 2024.

A Pittsburgh area archeologist and historian, Ron authored "Story of Woodville: The History, Architecture, and Archaeology of a Western Pennsylvania Farm."

As a percussionist and timpanist of the McKeesport Symphony Orchestra, Ron

was also the owner of Carlisle Percussion Products, which hand-crafted timpani sticks and other percussion accoutrements.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Florence I. Carlisle; and father, Clarke M. Carlisle.
