Zgurzec, various bank cards and documents in the name of Robert Zgurzec (to include First Commonwealth card ending in 8147, expiration 1-16 Robert Zgurzec, Access Robert Zgurzec, Access card Robert Zgurzec, Gateway card Robert Zgurzec, Dollar Bank card ending in 0690, expiration 1-16 Robert Zgurzec, First National Bank ending in 4730, expiration 1-16 Robert Zgurzec, Giant Eagle card and 6 paper cards (Cell Phone Exchange, CVS, First Commonwealth, Affordable Maintenance, UPMC and SafeLink), and social security card in the name of Robert Zgurzec were seized on or about February 19, 2013 subsequent to the arrest of Robert Zgurzec and/or Michael Johnston, by the Jefferson Hills Police Department, at 565 Coal Valley Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Allegheny County, 15236 (Jefferson Regional Medical Center) and/or 3212 Check Drive, Clairton, Pennsylvania, Allegheny County, 15205, and are in the possession of the United States Secret Service.

Any claimants to the currency and/or property are hereby notified to file a claim with the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, in person at 436 Grant Street, Room 534, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15219 and to serve a copy of the claim on the Allegheny County District Attorney's Office, Asset Forfeiture Unit, at 436 Grant Street, Room 303, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15219 or electronically at [actionclaim@Alleghenycounty.pa.us](mailto:actionclaim@Alleghenycounty.pa.us), no later than January 29, 2025. If no claim is filed on or before January 29, 2025, the currency shall be summarily forfeited to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and transferred to the Allegheny County Department of Court Records for application to outstanding restitution at Criminal Case numbers 201302783, 201304130, 201307125 and 201307127 and that said coins will be forfeited to the Commonwealth in the custody of the District Attorney to be sold and said proceeds (after commission, costs and/or fees) shall be transferred to the Allegheny County Department of Court Records to be applied to restitution at Criminal Case numbers 201302783, 201304130, 201307125 and 201307127 and that said remaining property listed above shall be disposed of in appropriate manner by the United States Secret Service and/or the Allegheny County District Attorney.
