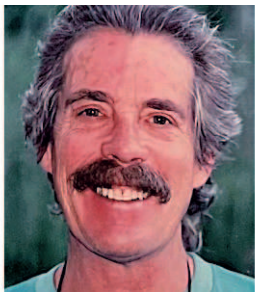


ROBERT BRYSON "BOB" "CHAT" CHATHAM
