

# **DR. FARRELL LEE JACKSON, JR.**



Doctor Farrell L. Jackson, DDS, 88, of Venetia, PA, and Naples, FL, passed away on Monday, December 16, 2024.

Farrell was born in Marianna, PA, to the late Farrell Jackson, Sr. and the late Helen (Kamenski).

He graduated from Centerville High School in 1954, where he was an outstanding football and basketball player. He graduated in 1962, from the University of Pittsburgh

School of Dentistry, and was a member of Psi Omega dental fraternity. Upon graduating from Pitt, he served with the 31st U.S. Army Field Hospital in Korat, Thailand. After being honorably discharged from the Army, he practiced dentistry in the South Hills for 30 years. During the 1970s, he was the team dentist for the Pittsburgh Penguins.

Farrell is survived by his wife, Joanne (Apa) Jackson; brothers, John, Robert, and William; and several nieces and nephews.

Military honors and interment will be private and held in the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies.
