After graduating Boys Latin in 1950, he attended University of Richmond (BA), Union Theological Seminary and Johns Hopkins University (MA). After briefly teaching

locally, he took a position at Butler County Community College, Butler, PA. He married fellow colleague, Nancy Markel and after 30 years, retired as an Associate Professor of the Social Sciences. Post career, he continued to develop his talents in sailing, drawing, cello, wood carving and delighting, all who knew him with his humor and gentle nature. Tim could do just about anything, from plowing fields with his father's 1950 tractor to patrol duty on his sailboat, Shenandoah II for the Coast Guard Auxiliary. For years, he split his time between Annapolis, MD and Sewickley, PA, where he lived with his wife of 50 years and dog at Masonic Village. He was considered a modern Renaissance Man because of his vast academic knowledge, skill with the cello, banjo and harmonica and many natural talents. Forever young at heart, professor to thousands of students and beloved by all who knew him, Tim, or "TP" as he signed his drawings, was the last of his family line and passed on gracefully at 91 years.
