He retired in 1995 as Emeritus Professor from California University of PA. Al had always been actively involved in libraries. He served on the Board of the Monessen Public Library and Professor after many years in Manderino Library, retiring in 1995. He was also very active in the Orthodox Christian Church, serving on the Parish Councils of St. Nicholas Church in Donora, PA, and Holy Spirit Orthodox Church of Venice, FL.
