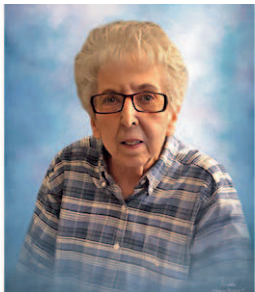


ANGELA F. "ANGIE" FEHL
