

# WALLACE "BUTCH" BIERNACKI



Age 76, of Pittsburgh, passed away at home on Wednesday, January 1, 2025.

Butch was born in Bethel Park on May 12, 1948, to the late Wallace "Kid" and Margaret Biernacki.
