Ron served in the U.S. Army Ordinance Corps as a 1st lieutenant at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, AL. His distinguished career started at Gulf Oil Corporation and continued at Carnegie-Mellon University, where he was a faculty member of the Electrical and Computer Engineering Department (ECE). While at CMU, he founded and led the Carnegie Mellon Research Institute (CMRI) Cybersecurity Center.

Ron holds seven U.S. Patents and has authored 16 books in the areas of cyber security and microprocessors. Later in his career, he was a professor at Webster University, a Distinguished Visiting Lecturer at the Univ of New Haven and a Sr. Fellow of the International Cyber Center of George Mason University.
