Moreover, compliance is required by the prime contractor and all subcontractors with the Federal General Conditions 135.38. Moreover, compliance is required by the prime contractor and all subcontractors with the Federal General Conditions included in the contract documents between the County of Allegheny through its Department of Economic Development and the operating agency. These Federal General Conditions are to be incorporated by reference into all construction contracts between operating agency and contractor, contractor and contractor, contractor and subcontractor(s), and lower tiered subcontractor(s) and lower tiered subcontractor(s). Bidder s will be required to provide Bid Security in the form of a Bid Bond, or certified check made payable to POWER, of asum no less than 5 percent (5%) of the Bid Price. The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers. After acceptance by the Owner, the Owner will issue to the successful bidder a written notice to proceed. No bid or any part thereof shall be withdrawn by the Bidder for a period of ninety (90) days subsequent to the bid opening.
