

Notice of an Intent to Remediate to an Environmental Standard (Sections 302(e)(1)(ii), 303(h)(1)(ii), 304(n)(1)(i), and 305(c)(1)) Pursuant to the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act, the act of May 19, 1995, P.L. 4, No. 1995-2, notice is hereby given that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection a Notice of Intent to Remediate for a site located at 101 Sgt. Messerschmidt Road, Collier Township, Allegheny County. This Notice of Intent to Remediate states that the site was found to be contaminated with arsenic in soil on the site, and asbestos-containing material was encountered in debris at the site. A background study conducted at the site determined that arsenic is present at background concentrations. The FAA has selected the Background Standard. No debris remains on the surface of the site, and soil sampled beneath debris did not contain asbestos. Therefore, the FAA proposes no remedial actions for the site. The property is owned by the United States of America and is currently used as a radar facility by the FAA. No changes in property use or ownership are currently planned.
