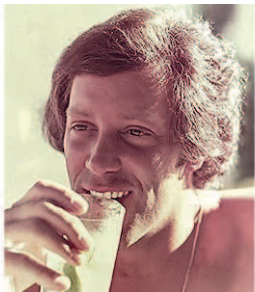


PATRICK JAMES ZANGRILLI
