Notice PURSUANTIO PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED STATUTES TITLE 73 SECTION 2303 Giant Eagle, Inc. (GEI) provides this notice in accordance with Title 73 Section 2303 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to advise of a limited data security issue that may have affected certain customers who visited two GEI stores recently. GEI identified a payment card skimmer installed on a checkout lane PIN pad at 4250 Murray Avenue in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on December 23, 2024, and at 3812 O'Neil Boulevard, McKeesport, PA 15132 on December 29, 2024. Subsequent investigation confirmed that a small number of names, payment card numbers and service codes may have been captured by the skimming devices installed at the two GEI stores. All skimming devices were immediately removed upon discovery. However, it is possible that payment card numbers and service codes were captured by the scimming devices installed at the two GEI stores. All skimming devices were immediately removed upon discovery. However, it is possible that payment card numbers and service card numbers and service codes were captured by the skimming devices for cards that were swiped during a limited period of time at the affected registers. Because most GEI customers insert or tapped their chipped cards, those GEI customers are not affected. GEI believes that a small number of customers that swiped that a small number of customers that swiped their cards could have been affected and encourages anyone who recently made a purchase at one of the identified locations by swiping their payment card to review their card statement for any unusual charges and report any such charges to their payment card issuer. In response to this incident, GEI has retrained store employees to identify skimming devices, and applied anti-tampering clips on payment system PIN pads.
