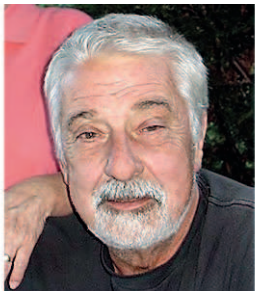


JAMES "JIM" CHARLES SCHMIDT
