

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS  
BOROUGH OF SEWICKLEY

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Borough of Sewickley, 601 Thorn Street, Sewickley, PA 15143 **until 10:00 AM on March 19, 2025**, to be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter at the Sewickley Municipal Building for the following project:

**WAR MEMORIAL PARK  
STREAM RESTORATION:  
PHASE 2**

This project consists of improvements to an existing stream and installation of in-stream structures, including a boulder cascade, an imbricated boulder step, single log vanes, a rock crossvane, and log deflectors, along with areas of bank stabilization, including branch layering, toe wood with branch layering, rock toe with branch layering, bank grading, and gravel bar removal. The project also includes the installation of imbricated boulder walls and a log step structure, as well as the installation, maintenance, and removal of sediment control devices; landscaping; and all associated site restoration to be completed in place. All Proposals must be in the hands of Donna Kaib, Borough Manager, Borough of Sewickley, 601 Thorn Street, Sewickley, PA 15143 on or before 10:00 AM prevailing time, March 19, 2025. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words **WAR MEMORIAL PARK STREAM RESTORATION: PHASE 2**. A **non-mandatory** pre-bid meeting will be held on February 25, 2025 at 10:00 AM. The meeting will begin in the parking lot of War Memorial Park, located at Blackburn Road, Sewickley, PA 15143.

**The Borough will consider bids from Contractors and or Subcontractors that can demonstrate prior completion of at least three (3) natural stream channel restoration projects utilizing natural channel design methods developed by Rosgen within the past three (3) years. Information on the prior projects and contact information shall be submitted with the Bid for review. If a subcontractor is utilized, the subcontractors prior work must be submitted with the prime contractor's proposal.**

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreements are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc, 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained starting on February 13, 2025 after payment of \$50.00 for the contract. No refunds will be made to documents purchased. A \$10.00 mailing fee will be applied if a Contractor requests that documents be mailed. **Electronic copies will be available free of charge.** To request electronic copies, please email [Sutton@gatewayengineers.com](mailto:Sutton@gatewayengineers.com). Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Churchill Borough in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. **Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage rates are required to be paid on this project.** The Proposals must be made to the Borough of Sewickley, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the ninety (90) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee. Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder. Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 -1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses. The Borough reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein. The Bidder is advised that the Borough will award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder based on the total bid submitted and natural stream channel restoration verification. However, the bidder is advised that the Borough expressly reserves the right to reject all bids, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest responsible bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.
