Peter C. Nicholson, 76, of Albany Township, ME, passed away on Wednesday, February 19, 2025, at Stephen's Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. Peter was born in Hackensack, NJ, on March 31, 1948, to parents George and Rosemary (McHugh) Nicholson.

Peter graduated from Mt. Lebanon High School near Pittsburgh, PA, in 1969. He was a member of St. Bernard's Catholic Church for

over 40 years, where he was an usher and active with the annual May Market. He volunteered at the Mt. Lebanon Public Library for 25 years, and was well known throughout the community. Pete was employed throughout his life, working at many Pittsburgh restaurants. He was actively involved in assisting and managing youth sports teams through the '70s, '80s, and '90s. Pete loved and was loved by his Maine family, including Maggie, Elyana, and Amy Davis. His closest friendship was with Mary Davis, who engaged Pete in activity, laughter, and unconditional love.

He is survived by his niece, Ann Nicholson and her husband, Tom Davis, with whom he lived for nearly 30 years, both in Pittsburgh and in Maine; his brothers, Bob (Mary Tarbox) of Cedar Rapids, IA; Don (Diane) of Asheville, NC, who assisted in managing Pete's care; Dave (Dot Skoko) of Pittsburgh, PA, who enjoyed Pittsburgh activities with Pete; and sister-in-law Gail Galloway Nicholson (Michael, deceased) of Camden, ME.
