Lifelong Oakmont-Verona resident, John (Monenti) Young, age 93, died on Monday, March 3, 2025. A Korean War veteran, he was a member of St. Irenaeus Catholic Church, the Verona Eagles, and the Oakmont Elks. A retired foreman from Allegheny Label Co. in Cheswick, he was the charter president of its Pittsburgh Union.

His community involvement included appointments to the Oakmont Recreation Board and the Borough's Tree Commission.

Devoted husband of Rita (Olpere) Young for the past 70 years, John was the adopted son of the late Curtis and Mary Young.
