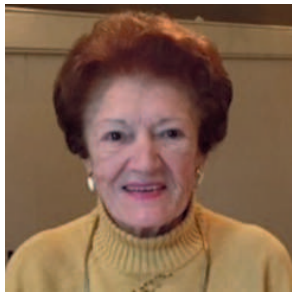


ELIZABETH "BETTY ANN" FREEHLING
