The purpose of this public hearing is to discuss the housing, homeless, other special, community development, economic development, and administrative and planning needs for the Municipality of Penn Hills' Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program through the Allegheny County HOME Consortium. These needs will be incorporated into the Municipality's FY 2025-2029 Five Year Consolidated Plan and FY 2025 Annual Action Plan. All interested residents are encouraged to attend this public hearing and will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the needs of the residents of the Municipality of Penn Hills and the use of CDBG and HOME funds to address those needs over the next five (5) years.
