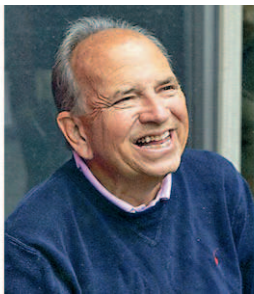


EDWARD R. WOLFORD
