A new pump station and gravity/force main piping will be constructed to transfer water collected from the solids settling process from the existing lagoons on Davis Island under the Ohio River backchannel and direct discharge into an interceptor sewer owned and operated by the Allegheny County Sanitary Authority (ALCOSAN) sanicary Additionally (ALCOSAN).
Final treatment will occur at the ALCOSAN wastewater treatment plant located on Pittsburgh's North Side. The flow generated from the project is estimated to be 100,000 gallons per day or 250 equivalent dwelling units (EDUs). As part of the PADEP requirements, projects that alter flow at existing sewage treatment facilities by more than 50,000 gallons per day or expend more than \$100,000 must provide a public notice.
