The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – Baltimore District will hold a public meeting to update the community and interested parties on planned fieldwork for the former Allegheny Arsenal Burial Pits Munitions – Response Site (MRS) Phase 1 Remedial Investigation. **The planned topics for the meeting are presented below:** Project Purpose and Objectives, Site Overview and Historical Background, Planned Field Activities and Schedule, Open forum and responses to community questions. The goal of this project is to complete geophysical surveys and identify anomalies that potentially represent discarded cannonballs or other military munitions that may still exist at this historic site as single items or within burial pits.
