He and his parents came to the United States in 1949 and first settled in North Carolina, later moving to New York, and then finally moved to Pittsburgh when he was 13, where he lived the rest of his life. Alex is survived by his high school sweetheart, Mimi Botkin; his two daughters, Ellen Botkin (Ben Chloros) and

Kira Harris (Todd Harris); and his grandchildren, Elijah, Nicholas, and Aurelia. Alex was incredible at building, fixing, and creating and later in life became a skilled woodworker and built an entire studio in his garage that he shared with friends old and new.
