Notice is hereby given that Allegheny County is currently preparing its 2025-2029 Five-Year Consolidated Plan, and FY2025 Annual Action Plan, as required by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, to determine the types of projects that will benefit County residents. In accordance with the Final Rule for consolidation of the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Programs, 24 CFR Part 91, et. al., the County will prepare a Consolidated Strategy and Annual Plan, which will be submitted to HUD at such time as directed by HUD. Citizen comments are important and will help to determine housing, economic development, and community development needs for the period July 1, 2025-June 30, 2030. In accordance with the Allegheny County Citizen Participation Plan, the County will hold a public hearing on Thursday, April 17, 2025, at **11:00 AM** at the Allegheny County Department of Economic Development Koppers Building; 436 Seventh Avenue, Confluence Room; Pittsburgh, PA 15219. Persons wishing to participate virtually may join via **Microsoft Teams**. The purpose of this public hearing is to accept citizen comments for the use of approximately \$13,200,000 of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), \$2,625,000 HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and \$1,175,000 Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) funds. These are estimated amounts. Actual allocations will be included in the final submission to HUD. Comments on prior use of the funds and program performance will also be accepted. In addition, the County will accept comment on its proposed substantial amendment to the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan. A copy of the proposed amendment is available for public review at Allegheny County Department of Economic Development Koppers Building; 436 Seventh Avenue, Confluence Room; Pittsburgh, PA 15219 through April 18, 2025. All interested citizens are encouraged to attend this public hearing as they will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan and FY2025 Annual Action Plan.
