### Request for Proposal PROJECTS TO PROVIDE HOUSING, SUPPORTIVE SERVICES, AND NON-CONGREGATE SHELTER TO ASSIST INDIVIDUALS OR HOUSEHOLDS WHO ARE HOMELESS OR AT RISK OF HOMELESSNESS

Allegheny County is seeking proposals from nonprofit organizations, developers, service providers, or subrecipient organizations to develop rental units and/or non-congregate shelter units serving households experiencing homelessness or other eligible populations. The County has received a special allocation of the HOME Investment Partnership Program funds through the 2021 American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The County has allocated a portion of these funds to development of these housing units. The goal of these activities is to reduce the frequency and severity of homelessness in Allegheny County. **Please Note:** Allegheny County and the City of Pittsburgh are considered two separate project jurisdictions for the purposes of this grant. As such Allegheny County is considering proposed projects located in or outside of the City of Pittsburgh.
