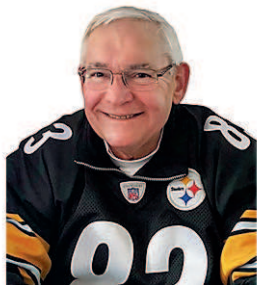


# ANDREW ROBERT CENCARIK
